Made in the Monaro inc. invites all age groups to share their skills and enter a wearable arts competition at the traditional arts and craft fair at the Cooma railway station on the 11th of November 2023. The theme is, 'Remembrance day', however garments do not have to fit the theme.

Made in the Monaro is a not for profit community based Arts and Craft Organization. The aim of the group is to promote, share and foster traditional arts and crafts in our local community. Contest participants are limited to 2 entries per section, entries for adults must be individual, for school entries they can be group or individual.. Any subject is acceptable as long items that can be worn in a fashion parade at the Railway Station platform on the day.

To enter a garment in the contest, see the contest guidelines and judging criteria and fill out the garment Entry Form. Return the entry form and garment to Made in the Monaro shop front 49 Vale street Cooma by the 1st Nov 2023 :

CONTEST SECTIONS:

1: Any Traditional garment made from textile products. (Student and Adults) – The Garment could be of any traditional description and can be made from any textile medium. The items will be judged in the following categories: Preschool/ Primary/ High school/ Adult (school aged entries can be group projects)

2: Any garment made from Recycled products (Student and Adults) – The Garment could be any style of garment, this garment is to be constructed using recyclable materials. The items will be judged in the following categories: Preschool/ Primary/ High school/ Adult (school aged entries can be group projects)

Entry fee:

\$5 per item.

DISPLAY:

The garments will be fashion paraded at the traditional art and craft fair at the Cooma Railway Station on the 11th nov at 12:30.

Please provide details if you'd like to provide a willing model for the fashion parade on the day.

AWARDS:

The top judged entries will receive gift vouchers for Made in the Monaro valued at \$50.

Plus People's Choice Award: The garment that receives the most votes by fair attendees will receive a cash award of \$200.

JUDGING:

Judging will be based on the criteria listed below.. Garments will be judged by a panel of peers. The general criteria for each category are listed below:

Section 1 Judging Criteria:

Design and Presentation: A good garment is designed creatively with an appropriate balance between wearability, comfort, construction and design.

Section 2 Judging Criteria:

Design and Presentation: A good garment is designed creatively with an appropriate balance between wearability, comfort, construction and design. This garment should reflect and embody wearable art.

Use of Recycled items : This garment should be constructed of at least 80% recycled materials.
