

Housed in the beautifully restored Cooma Railway Station building, the Cooma Monaro Railway Museum tells the story of the golden age of railways in NSW. Take a wander through our 'Travel for Pleasure' exhibition, explore one of the last remaining, complete railway precincts in NSW and view some of our beautifully restored rolling stock.

The railway precinct at Cooma is one of the last remaining intact railway yards in New South Wales with much of the railway infrastructure still in place.

Exhibits:

Travel for Pleasure Exhibit – Housed in the beautifully restored Parcel Office, the exhibit takes a walk through the golden era of railway travel, including the mighty Kosciusko Express.

Local History – Take a look at some of the people who were pivotal to the operation of the railway in the Monaro.

Restored Buildings – Wander through the restored buildings around the precinct, including the Station Masters Office and Signal Box.

Cooma Railway Yard – Explore the last remaining complete example of a steam-era railway yard in New South Wales.

Rolling Stock – Get up close to our resident steam locomotive 3203, operational CPH Railmotors, our restored explosives van PV22318 or one of the many restoration projects currently underway.
